INTRODUCTION

IT IS WITH THIS PRINCIPLE IN MIND THAT THE OFFICE OF INSTITUTIONAL RESEARCH AND THE OFFICE OF ACADEMIC AFFAIRS AND RESEARCH PRESENT THIS PROFILE OF THE OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT BODY. THIS DOCUMENT IS DESIGNED TO PRESENT DESCRIPTIVE INFORMATION ON PREVIOUS AND PRESENT OSU STUDENTS AND TO DEPICT TREND DATA IN A MANNER WHICH IS USEFUL IN PLANNING FOR THE CHALLENGES WHICH LIE AHEAD. IT IS TO BE USED AS AN INTERNAL REFERENCE FOR HELPING THE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY TO BETTER UNDERSTAND THE UNIVERSITY'S MOST IMPORTANT RESOURCE -- ITS STUDENTS.

THE INFORMATION PRESENTED WILL PROVIDE INSIGHT INTO SUCH QUESTIONS AS:

- -- WHAT ARE THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PRESENT OSU STUDENT BODY?
- -- FROM WHERE DO OSU STUDENTS COME?
- -- WHAT HAVE BEEN THE ENROLLMENT TRENDS?
- -- WHAT ARE THE ACADEMIC POTENTIALS OF OSU STUDENTS?
- -- HOW MANY STUDENTS PERSIST TO GRADUATION?
- -- WHAT ARE THE PROJECTED ENROLLMENTS FOR OSU?

MOST OF THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THIS REPORT IS A PART OF THE REGULAR REPORTING SYSTEM OF THE OFFICE OF INSTITU-

TIONAL RESEARCH. HOWEVER, THESE MATERIALS HAVE NOT PREVIOUS-LY BEEN COMPILED INTO ONE COMPREHENSIVE PROFILE OF OSU STU-DENTS AS THEY ARE PRESENTED IN THIS BOOK. OBVIOUSLY, A REPORT OF THIS TYPE CANNOT ANTICIPATE ALL QUESTIONS WHICH WILL ARISE, AND THERE ARE OTHERS WHICH CANNOT BE ANSWERED DUE TO UNAVAILABILITY OF DATA. THIS DOCUMENT, HOWEVER, DOES PROVIDE AN INITIAL BASE OF INFORMATION WHICH CAN BECOME A USEFUL PLANNING TOOL.

THIS PROFILE IS INTENDED AS A "LIVING DOCUMENT" TO WHICH ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WILL BE ADDED; THE CURRENT PLAN IS TO UPDATE THE ENTIRE REPORT EACH YEAR.

SO THAT IT MAY BECOME A MORE EFFECTIVE DOCUMENT, ITS USERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO DIRECT THEIR COMMENTS, QUESTIONS, AND SUGGESTIONS ABOUT ITS CONTENTS TO THE OFFICE OF INSTITUTIONAL RESEARCH.











RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY




NON-RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE




SOURCE OF OSU GRADUATE STUDENTS BY RESIDENT STATUS

RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY




NON-RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE




SOURCE OF OSU MINORITY STUDENTS BY RESIDENT STATUS


RESIDENT MINORITY STUDENTS BY COUNTY




NON-RESIDENT MINORITY STUDENTS BY STATE




DISTRIBUTION OF OSU INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS TOP TEN COUNTRIES - FALL SEMESTER 1981






OSU ENROLLMENT BY SEX - FALL SEMESTERS 1962-81








OSU ENROLLMENT PERCENT OF CHANGE FALL SEMESTER 1976 TO FALL SEMESTER 1981










NINE YEAR COMPARISON OF ACT SCORES FOR OSU NEW FRESHMEN FALL SEMESTERS 1973-81



COMPOSITE ACT AVERAGE OF OSU NEW FRESHMEN BY SEX FALL SEMESTERS 1977-81



COMPOSITE ACT AVERAGES OF OSU NEW FRESHMEN BY RACE 1977-81




AVERAGE CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF OSU STUDENTS BY CLASS LEVEL






AVERAGE CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF OSU STUDENTS BY COLLEGE





OSU FALL SEMESTER HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS

THE OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT BODY IS NORMALLY COMPOSED OF ABOUT 90% RESIDENT AND 10% NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS. FOR THE 1981 FALL SEMESTER THIS DISTRIBUTION HAS CHANGED TO 88% AND 12%, RESPECTIVELY. ALSO, THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS WITH RESIDENT STATUS ALMOST ALWAYS ARE GRADUATES OF AN OKLAHOMA HIGH SCHOOL. THUS, THE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS OF OKLAHOMA ARE THE MAJOR SOURCE OF OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT.

EACH YEAR THE OKLAHOMA STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION PUBLISHES A REPORT ILLUSTRATING THE FLOW OF STUDENTS IN PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS OF OKLAHOMA. THIS DOCUMENT IS THE SOURCE FROM WHICH WE PROJECT OKLAHOMA PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES FOR THE NEXT ELEVEN YEARS IN ORDER TO PROJECT THE BEGINNING NEW FRESHMEN CLASS AT OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY.

A RETENTION STUDY IS DONE EACH FALL ILLUSTRATING THE FLOW OF STUDENTS FROM CLASS TO CLASS WITH RESPECT TO PREVIOUS FALL SEMESTER TO PRESENT FALL SEMESTER, UPON REVIEWING THESE STUDIES ONE FINDS THE RETENTION OF A SPECIFIC CLASS VARIES VERY LITTLE FROM YEAR TO YEAR, BUT THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE STUDENTS TO DIFFERENT CLASSES VARIES MORE. EXAMPLE: FOR THE FALL OF 1979, 68.2% OF THE FRESHMEN CLASS RETURNED THE FOLLOWING FALL OF 1980; FOR THE 1978 FALL SEMESTER, 68.2% OF THE FRESHMEN RETURNED THE FOLLOWING FALL OF 1979; BUT IN 1980, 11.8% OF THE FRESHMEN FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR WERE CLASSIFIED AS FRESHMEN, WHILE IN 1979 14.3% OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S FRESHMEN WERE CLASSIFIED AS FRESHMEN. USING THIS INFORMATION AS THE BASIS FOR THE PROJECTION MODELS, ONE CAN DEVELOP MODELS WHICH PROJECT THE OVERALL RETENTION BETTER THAN A PARTICULAR GROUP ADVANCING TO THE THIS METHOD DECREASES THE AMOUNT OF ERROR WHEN PROJECTING TOTAL HEADCOUNT.

A FACTOR WHICH MAY BECOME MORE OF AN INFLUENCE THAN IN PREVIOUS YEARS IS THE INCREASE IN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLLMENT. AT THE PRESENT TIME NO POLICY EXISTS LIMITING THEIR ENROLLMENT, THUS THEY COULD BECOME A MAJOR FACTOR FOR CONSIDERATION IN ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS.

GRADUATE ENROLLMENT IS NOT EASY TO PROJECT WITH RESPECT TO THE SAME VARIABLES AS UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT. THE JOB MARKET, AMOUNT OF FUNDING FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS FROM DEPARTMENTS AND EMPHASIS OF THE DEPARTMENTS ON RECRUITING ARE MAJOR FACTORS AFFECTING ENROLL-MENT AND MUST BE TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION WHEN MAKING PROJECTIONS. INPUT BY THE GRADUATE DEAN ON POLICY AND FUTURE FUNDING IS REFLECTED IN THE GRADUATE ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS.




