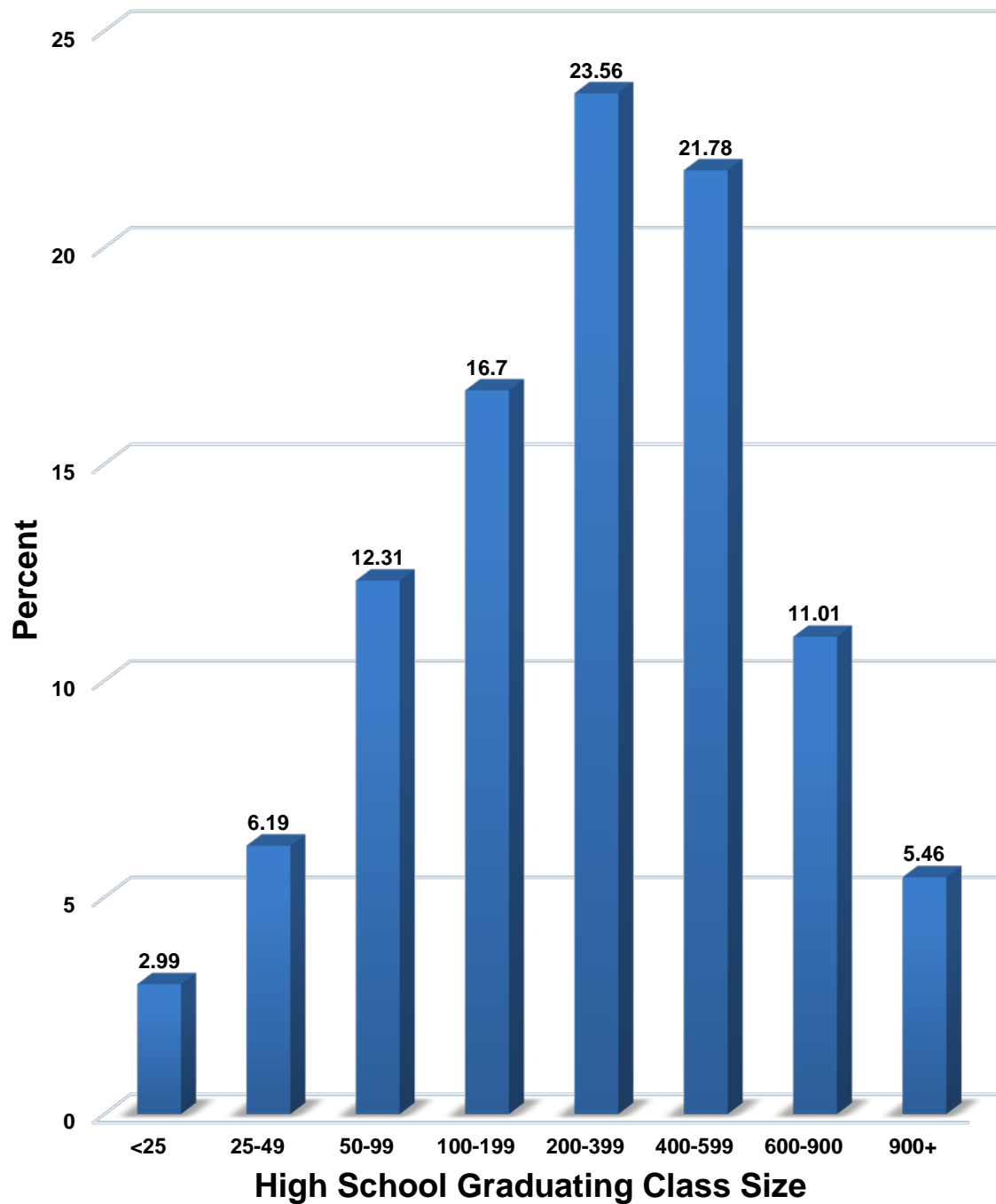

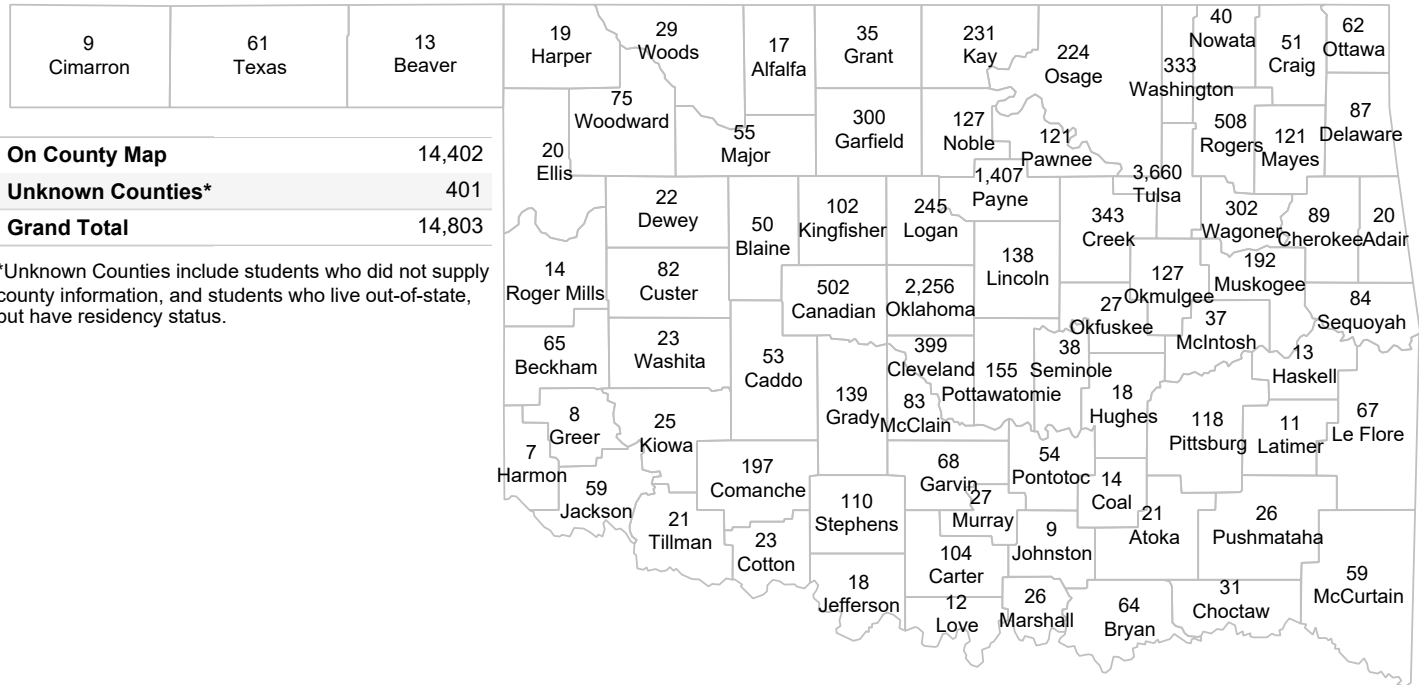

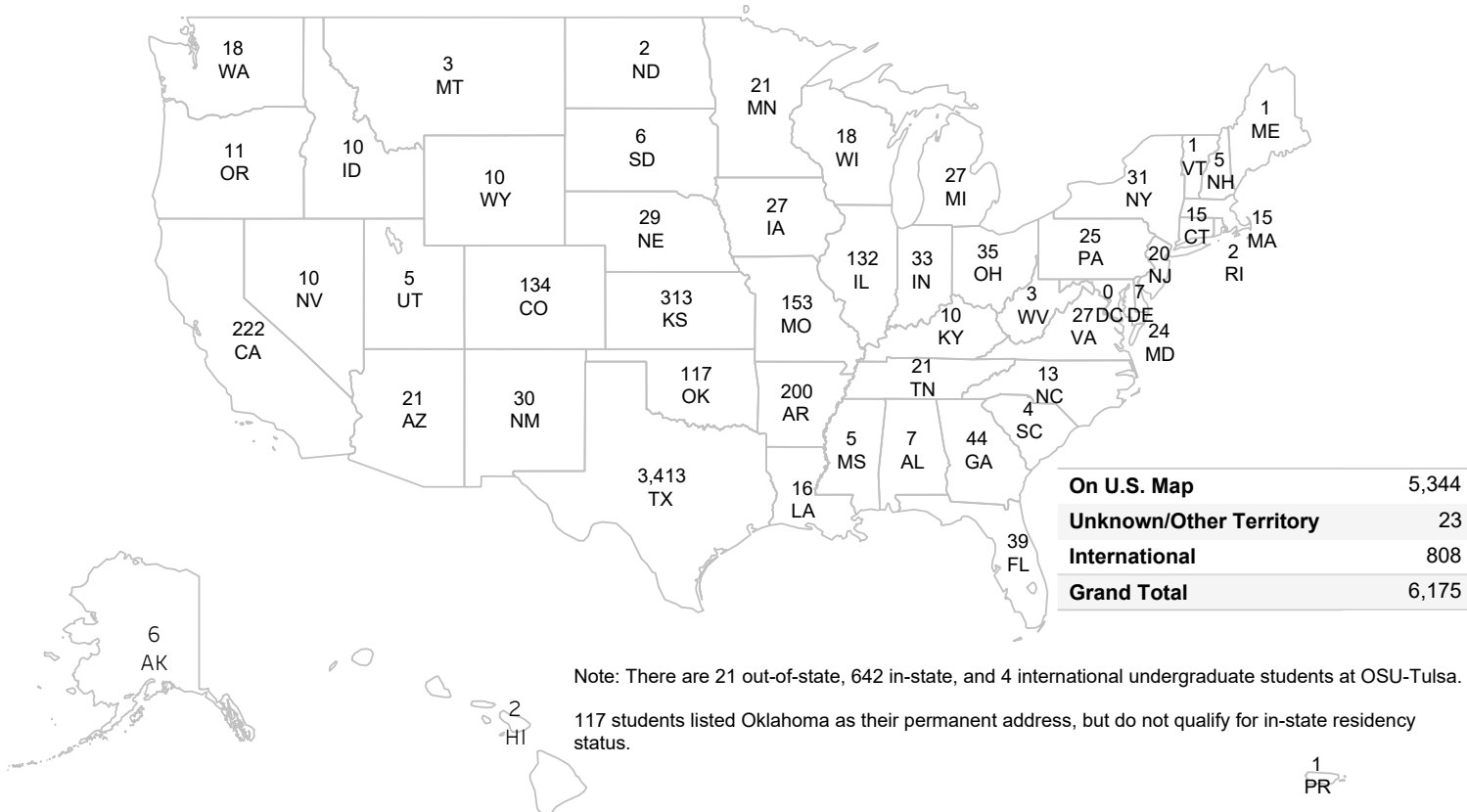

#### RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY



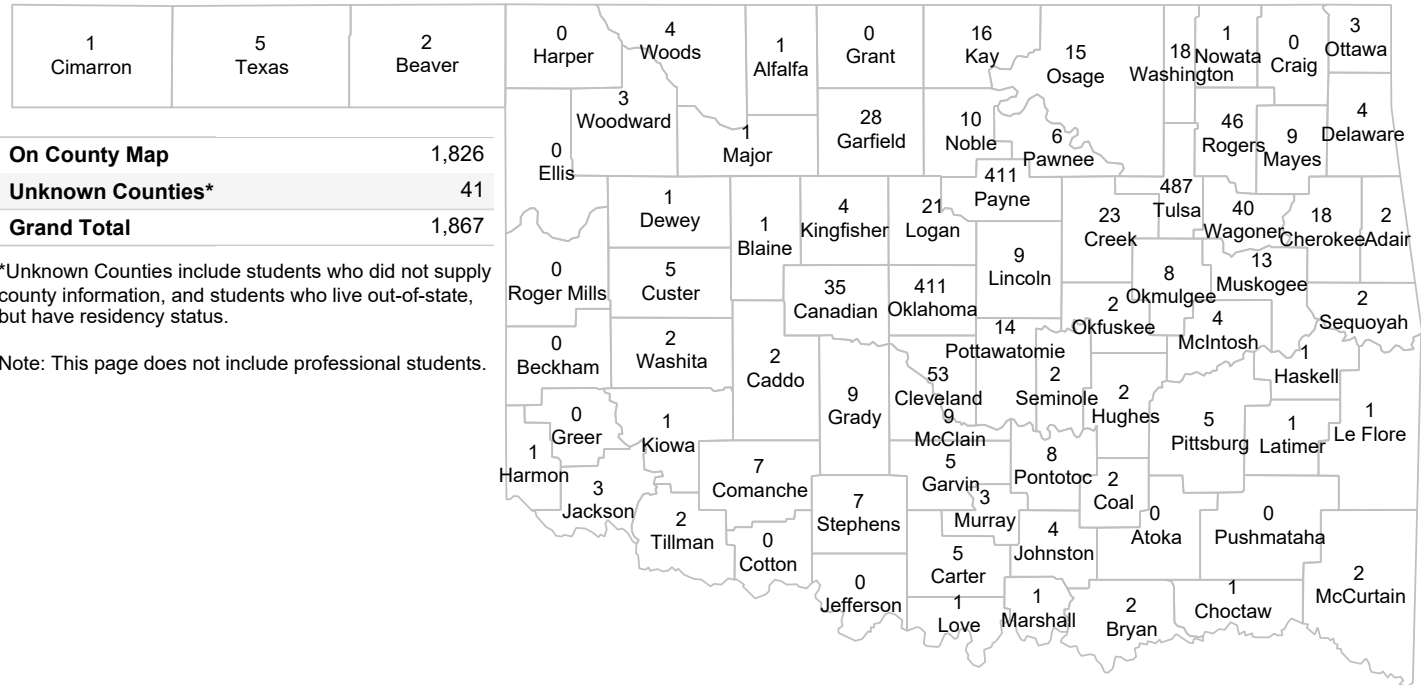

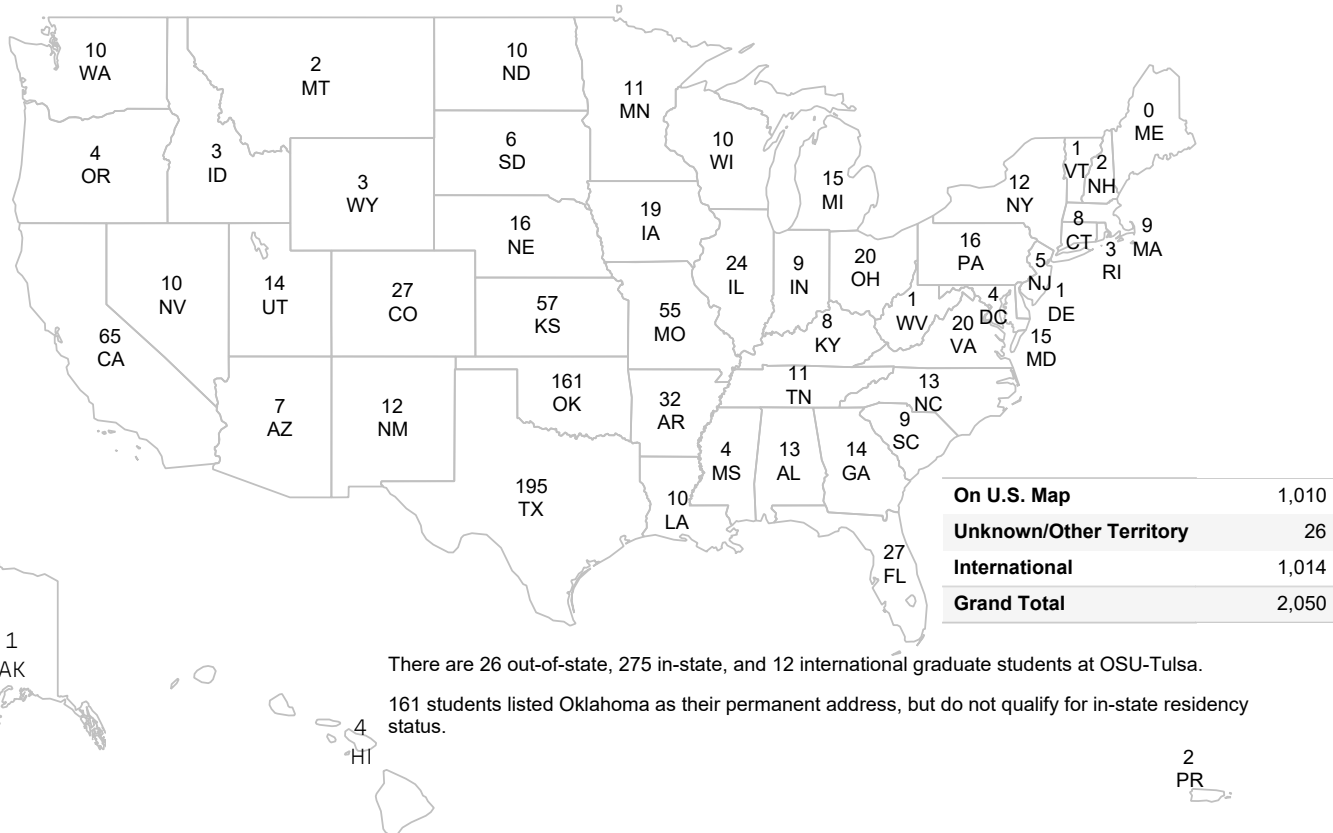

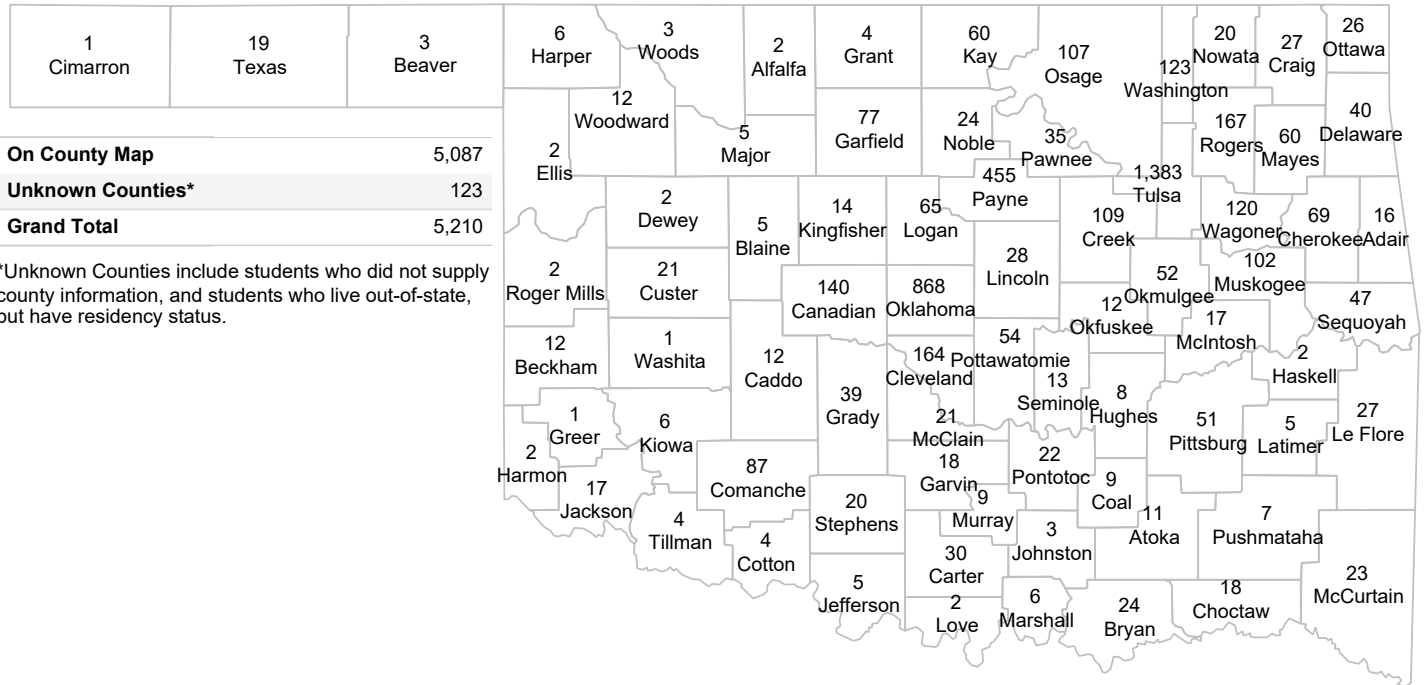

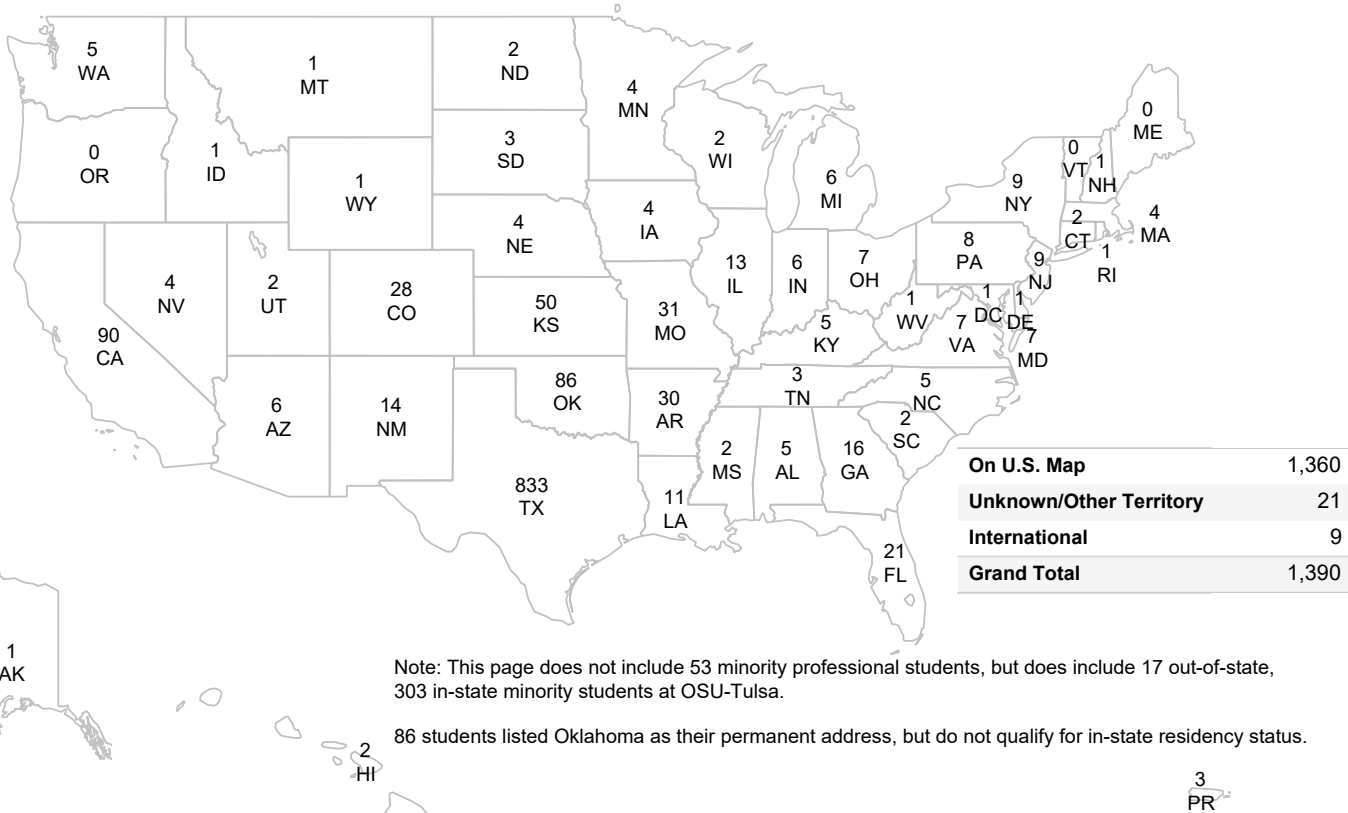
